Begins at a corner on the Mountain View Avenue at a
point 575 feet from Rutherford Road and running thence
through lot no. 3, a line practically parallel with Rutherford
Road S. 30° 41' 189.5 feet to a point, thence S. 65° 30' E. 75 feet to an
iron fence line of lot no. 3; thence through the center
of lots no. 3 & 36 S. 30° 41' 189.5 feet to the rear of Mountain View
