on Verner Heights, said lots fronting on Verner Street, and being known and designated
as Lots Nos. 3 6 and 3 8 as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 126; said
lots being each 40 by 150 feet, fronting on the southwest side of Verner Street,
which is 40 feet wide.The Southeast corner of lot No. 36 is 100 feet from the North side of Mountain
