all that place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

those two lots of land lying just outside the City of Greenville, being part of the Hammatt Estate, and being known as lots Nos. 20 and 21 as shown on a plat made by W. A. Hudson, May 14, 1800, Lot No. 20 fronting 100 feet on Pinckney Street and runs back to an alley (now Mills Street) and contains 44/100 of an acre, more or less, and lot No. 21 adjoins the above and fronts 100 feet on said Pinckney Street and runs back to said alley (now Mills street) and contains 44/100 or as sure, more or less, both of said lots having a depth of 180 feet, and being the same conveyed to M. C. Bradley by M. Inman, Master, January 20, 1822, deed recorded in Book 162, page 278."

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, against the said J. T. Styles and J. R. Styles, their heirs, executors and administrators to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
