TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

H. Bareley, Jr., W. H. Bareley and J. H. Bareley Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bellville, containing two acres more or less, near Parris Mountain, Road, about two miles from Greenville Court House, and having the following courses and distances, according to a survey made by H. D. Nees, September 1934:

Beginning at an iron pin in centre of Southern Railway Company right-of-way (old road bed), corner of three acre tract heretofore conveyed to Gravette's Heirs, running thence along centre of said right-of-way S. 84-15 E. 67 feet to stake, thence N. 12-48 E. 560 feet more or less to iron pin, thence S. 77-15 E. 360 feet to iron pin corner of three acre tract belonging to Gravette's, and thence with Gravette's line S. 40 E. 620 feet more or less to beginning corner.
