In the State aforesaid, the said land whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lois Boone Stanley

all that place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville, and having the following courses and distances according

to survey and plat by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, August, 1832.

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast corner of Belmont Avenue and Cleveland Street and running thence with Cleveland Street N. 88-33 W. 116' to iron pin corner of other property of grantor; thence S. 3-25 W. 178 feet to iron pin corner other property of grantor; thence N. 88-36 W. 117 feet to iron pin on Belmont Avenue; thence with Belmont Avenue N. 3-35 E. 183 feet to beginning.

The above described land is portion of the same conveyed to me by Thomas T. Goldsmith on the 6th day of November 1830, and recorded in office of Register of Deeds, Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 69, Page 131.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, appendages and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Lois Boone Stanley, her heirs and assigns forever.

AND, I, do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lois Boone Stanley, her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
