on the west side of Green Ave., having the following metes and bounds;

Beginning at an iron pipe on the west side of said Green Ave. at corner of lot sold by Perry Beattie to W. B. Holly and running along said lot in a northwesterly direction one hundred feet to a stake; thence in a northeasterly direction fifty feet, more or less, to a stake on lot sold by said Beattie to Cocke, (now property of D.
