## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

Brown.In the State aforesaid, the parties whose names are hereinafter acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ellen A. Brown, her heirs and executors,all that place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville,

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the City of Greenville, on the east side of Calhoun Street,

described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the east side of Calhoun Street about 26 feet from the northeast corner of Calhoun and Woodward Streets and running thence with Calhoun Street N. 18 E. 52 feet to a stake, thence S. 18 E. 200 feet to a stake, thence S. 18 W. 52 feet to a stake, thence N. 18 W. 200 feet to a stake on Calhoun Street at the foregoing corner, being lot No 17 on a plat recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in Plat Book W.W. page 605, and the said land conveyed to me, said Lewis Brown, by William last by his two respective deeds dated December 29, 1928, recorded in Deed Book 45, page 272, and deed dated May 11, 1929, recorded in Deed Book 134 page 403, said R.M.C. Office.
