convey unto the said J. Goldsmith Howard
all that gives, passes or lot of land in the CITY of Greenville, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and located on the Northwest corner of Hampton and Butler Avenues and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of Hampton and Butler
Avenues and running thence with Butler Avenue, E. 20-28 S. 150 feet 11 inches to an iron
pin; thence N. 69-05 W. 117.3 feet; thence N. 20-28 E. 59.3 feet to an iron pin; thence
N. 69-05 W. 49.3 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence across said alley, N. 69-05 W. 8
feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-10 W. 150 feet 6 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 51-12
feet 10 inches to the beginning corner.
