KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT I, W. G. SIRRINE,

In the State aforesaid One thousand one hundred forty eight and 39/100 Dollars

In consideration of the sum of Dollars,

To P. B. Pinson, as Liquidating Agent of the Bank of Conestee,
Conestee, South Carolina,

In the State aforesaid, the sum aforesaid is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said P. B. Pinson, as Liquidating Agent of the Bank of Conestee all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southwest corner of Watson and Grace Streets, as shown on a plat by Dalton & Nevers dated December, 1927 of the Watson property and known as lot #17 on the plat which is recorded in R. & C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 6, page 164. The lot is described as follows:

beginning at an iron pin on the corner of said streets and running thence with Grace Street N. 71-06 E. 124 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-18 E. 57 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 71-06 E. 124 feet 8 inches to an iron pin on Watson Street and thence with Watson Street N. 18-40 E. 57 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee shall have full power and authority in his sole discretion to sell and convey the above described lot, and to give a good and sufficient title thereto, without the consent or approval of any beneficiary under the trusteeship, and no purchaser of said lot shall be responsible for the disposition or use by the trustee of the purchase money.

The above described land is a portion of the same conveyed to me by Grace M. Griffith and Charles Watson on the 23rd, day of October, 1934, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County, in Book 179, Page 271.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, incidents, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, of and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said P. B. Pinson, as Liquidating Agent, his successors in office and heirs and assigns forever AND IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, W. G. SIRRINE, my wife and heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said P. B. Pinson, as Liquidating Agent, his successors in office and heirs and assigns forever and his wife, executors and administrators to whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, in any part thereof.
