in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary Frances Bowden, all of my right, title and interest, the one acre, more or less, situate in and of the Township of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

known and designated as Lot No. 56 of the subdivision known as Augusta Circle as shown on a Plat of record in the P. M. Co. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "7" at page 27, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
