

DEED TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Jessie B. Goodman (formerly Jessie J. Bowen)

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars,

to me paid by Lounes Hodges

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lounes Hodges all that place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the City of Greenville and being known and designated as Lots 20 and 21 of the subdivision of the Simon Earl property known as Oaklawn as per a survey and plat of the Fitzpatrick & Terry Co. dated May 6, 1920 and recorded in Plat Book "8" at page 273. Each lot having a frontage of 25 feet on Florence Avenue with a uniform depth of 125 feet and being the two same lots of land conveyed to the grantor, heron Jessie J. Bowen, now Jessie B. Goodman, by Rebecca J. White by deed dated September 20, 1924 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 96 at page 286.

It is understood and agreed that this conveyance is made subject to a mortgage of Jessie B. Goodman to The First Federal Savings and Loan Association in the sum of \$400.00 said mortgage recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book Vol 251 at page 189, but that the grantee herein expressly does not assume the same.
