Beginning at a point in the Scuffletown Road and running thence N. 35-45 W. 281 feet to an iron pin at a large oak tree; thence N. 63 E. 215 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-15 E. 205 feet to a point in said Scuffletown Road; thence along said road, S. 60-45 W. 154 feet to the beginning corner, and containing one acre more or less, and being the same land conveyed to the grantor herein by the grantee herein by deed dated October 16, 1932 and recorded in the R.
