 and bounds; Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Davis and Foster Streets and
 running thence S. 30°30' W. with line of Davis Street 42 feet to an iron pin, corner of
 lots Nos. 10 and 11, thence S. 65°30' E. 84 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 30°30' E. 40
 feet, to an iron pin on edge of Foster Street; thence N. 64°30' W. with said Foster Street
 96 feet to the beginning corner, being known and designated as Lot No. 11 as shown on plat
 made by W. D. Nease July 15, 1924, recorded in Plat Book C, page 288, R. M. C. Office for
