TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT J. H. Norwood, Trustee

In the State aforesaid.

In consideration of the sum of One thousand (\$1,000) Dollars,
and other valuable consideration
to me paid by Walborn Ross Lumber Company, a corporation.In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Walborn Ross Lumber Company, a corporationall that place, part or lot of land in Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
on the Southern side of Oliver Street, in a subdivision known as Alta Vista, known and
designated as Lot No. 59, according to a plat made by R. S. Dalton, Engineer, recorded
in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in "1st Book "G", at page 30, and being more
particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southern side of Oliver Street, joint Northern corner of
Lots Nos. 58 and 59; thence with the dividing line of said lots S. 4-15 W. 200 feet to
joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 59 S. 85-40 W. 62.5
feet to joint corner of Lots Nos. 59 and 60; thence along the dividing line of Lots No.
59 and 60 N. 4-15 E. 200 feet to a point on the Southern side of Oliver Street; thence
with Oliver Street N. 85-40 W. 62.5 feet to the point of beginning.

This deed is made under the authority of the trust-deed made originally to Norwood
National Bank, recorded in Deed Book 101, at page 23, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville
County, wherein Norwood National Bank was constituted trustee for this property, and the
decree of the Court of Common Pleas, changing and substituting J. W. Norwood, as Trustee,
now constituting Judgment Roll S-2267 on file in the office of the Clerk of Court of
Common Pleas for said Greenville County. See also Judgment Roll G-5384 in said office.

The above described land is deeded to me by J. H. Norwood, Trustee,
on the 11th day of March, 1936, deed recorded in office of Register
of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 101, Page 23.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or
appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Walborn Ross Lumber Company, a corporation,
and its successors, and assigns forever.

AND I, J. H. Norwood, do hereby bind myself, my executors, administrators to
warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Walborn Ross Lumber Company, a
corporation, and its successors, and assigns, for ever, and my successors,
whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to whom, the same, on any part thereof.
