

## LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,  
County of Greenville.

A. J. Burgess lessor,  
in consideration of the rental hereinbefore mentioned, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto

Piedmont Pawn Shop lessee,

for the following use, viz., Piedmont Pawn Shop Business Jewelry, Luggage and etc. agreed to lease to Uncle Sol's Store now in this City, the Grand Plaza, store now West of the joining of the alley back of the Parker Building for the term of one year beginning January 1, 1935.

In consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promises to pay the said lessor the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00)

Dollars.

per month payable in advance.

The lessee hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessor only require of the lessor the use of the premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the roof should it leak, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the lessor not to pay any damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the business is discontinued or the premises vacated before the expiration of the lease then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due and payable.

Outside signs to be erected that may conflict with the garage or any other outside part of the building must be consented to by the lessor before being erected.

To have and to hold the said premises unto the said lessee, their executors and administrators for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party sixty days months written notice previous to the time of the desired termination, but the destruction of the premises by fire or making it unfit for occupancy or other casualty, or months arrear of rent, shall terminate this lease, if the lessor so desires. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass and all other injuries done to the premises during the term, except such as are predicted by natural decay and agree to make no repairs, improvements or alterations in the premises without the written consent of the lessor nor sub-rent without the lessor written consent.

The lessee hereby acknowledges having a duplicate of this lease.
