## LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,  
County of Greenville.

Mrs. Eugenia A. Manos

In consideration of the rental hereinunder mentioned, have granted, bargained and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto

Peter Sasso

lessee,

For the following use, viz., Civil War

the  
Star Civil War Museum numbered 106 W Washington St in City & County  
of Greenville, beginning Jan 1, 1940 and ending  
Dec 31, 1942

and the said lessee

in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promises to pay the said lessor the sum of Twelve Hundred  
(\$1200.00) Dollars

per month, monthly during said term; beginning first payment on  
The lessor hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessee only requires of the lessor the use of the  
premises for the business mentioned, but no other. The lessee to repair the roof should it leak, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the  
lessor not to put out damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the  
lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the business is discontinued or the premises vacated before the expiration of the lease then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due  
and payable.

Outgoings might be incurred that may connect with the part or the other outside part of the building must be concealed to by the lessor before being  
assumed.

Lessee agrees to pay all expenses.

It is also agreed that the said premises under the said lease, Peter Sasso, his  
executors and administrators for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the  
party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party one (1) months written notice previous  
to the time of the desired termination, but the destruction of the premises by fire or making it unfit for occupancy or other casualty, or  
months agrees to void such termination this lease, if the lessor so desires. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass and all other injuries done to the  
premises during the term, except such as are produced by natural decay and agree to make no repairs, improvements or alterations in the premises without the  
written consent of the lessor and no cost without the lessee's written consent.

The lessor hereby acknowledges having a duplicate of this lease.
