

LEASE

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,
County of Greenville.

I, Eugenia A. Manor, called 949, lessor,
in consideration of the rental hereinafter mentioned, have granted, bargained, sold, aliened and by these presents do grant, bargain, and lease unto

Lillie Sasso (Mrs. Pete Sasso) lessee,

for the following use, viz.: for Cafe Business only
the store known numbered 108 1/2 and 110 1/2 West Washington Street in City
and County of Greenville, South Carolina, also property herein after stated
for the term of one (1) year beginning January 1, 1940 and ending
December 31st, 1940

in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, beginning to pay the said lessor the sum of Seventy

per Month payable monthly, on the 1st day of each month
during the life of said lease, beginning on February 1st, 1940.
The lessee hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessee shall be bound for the use of the premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the roof should it leak, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the lessor not to pay any damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the lessor so desires, and give notice of same in writing.

If the business is discontinued on the premises wanted before the expiration of the lease then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due and payable.

Outside signs to be erected that may connect with the premises or any other outside part of the building must be consented to by the lessor before being erected.

This lease also includes also, all furniture and
fixtures of every kind now on said premises.

To Have and to hold the said premises unto the said lessee Lillie Sasso (Mrs. Pete Sasso)
executors and administrators for the said term. It is agreed by the parties hereto that this lease shall continue from year to year on the same terms, unless the
party desiring to terminate it after the expiration of the term above mentioned give to the other party Three (3) months written notice previous
to the time of the desired termination, but the destruction of the premises by fire or making it unfit for occupancy or other casualty, or Three (3)
months arrear of rent, shall terminate this lease, if the lessor so desires. The lessee agree to make good all breakage of glass and all other injuries done to the
premises during the term, except such as are produced by natural decay and agree to make no repairs, improvements or alterations in the premises without the
written consent of the lessor nor sub-rent without the lessors written consent.
