the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Do hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Macie V. Parkinson:-

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side  
of West Croft Street in the City of Greenville, and being more particularly described as  
follows:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of West Croft Street, which iron pin  
is 170 feet in a Westerly direction from the Southwest corner of Townes and Croft Streets,  
and running thence S. 1-41 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on a 16 foot alley; thence along the  
line of said alley, N. 83-13 W. 65.5 feet to an iron pin on said alley; thence N. 1-41 E.  
200 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Croft Street; thence along the line of said  
Street, S. 83-13 E. 65.5 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same property conveyed  
to me by T. C. Gower and Hall G. Parrish, as Executrix of the Estate of W. D. Parrish,  
deceased, dated March 29, 1932, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County  
in Deed Volume 160 at page 69.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the Grantee assumes and agrees to  
pay a certain mortgage on the above property executed by Mattie C. Reynolds to Mrs. J. H.  
Alawine, C. W. Alawine and Ansel Alawine, a partnership doing business as Taylor Lumber  
Company, dated June 13, 1932, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County  
in Mortgages Volume 225 at page 179, upon which there is due the principal sum of \$3465.00.
