Power of Attorney.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, Irene S. Nightingale, (revoking all existing powers of attorney by me made) on this date, in said State and County, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00), receipt whereof is acknowledged, and in consideration of my confidence in and affection for my sister, Florence N. League, do hereby constitute and appoint the said Florence N. League my true and lawful attorney of fact, with full powers below set out, and with full power to do for me as fully as I might do, all things by her deemed necessary or advisable to make said powers effective:-

(1) Power to take into her possession for care and safe-keeping, and to receive and receipt for, in my name, all stocks, bonds, evidences of debt, papers and personal property of any and every kind;- and to collect for me and receipt for all interest, dividends, and income now due or hereafter becoming due to me or my estate on any account;

(2) Power to reduce to possession any rights of action that may heretofore have accrued, or may hereafter accrue, in my favor, and to safely keep same or the proceeds thereof, and account for same to me and my estate;

(3) Power to succeed as my attorney of fact, my brother, Joseph A. Nightingale who has heretofore been acting in that capacity; I expressly revoke his power of attorney and request and direct him to deliver all my stocks, bonds, papers and other property, to my said sister, her receipt to operate as a discharge from any further liability for whatever he may deliver to her. And I give her full power hereunder to sell at her discretion and to make title to any property or rights that I have, or may have.
