Whereas, at an auction sale under a decree of court dated Dec 20, 1928, in the case of Ella Leonard against D. D. Leonard et al, White Horse Lodge No. 200 Free and Accepted Masons bought a certain lot of land situated in Greenville County, South Carolina containing one-half acre more or less, hereinafter a part of lot no. 5 of the Leonard land and said lot was conveyed by Deed in Warranty to George Williams, J. D. Franklin and H. C. H. Bennett, as trustees of said lodge by deed dated May 11, 1929, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds in this jurisdiction in Book 149, page 92 and whereas, to pay for said land, said trustees borrowed the sum of five hundred dollars from Chas. Brown and gave him a note for said sum and a mortgage covering said land and bearing date the said 11th day of May, 1929 and recorded in said office in Book 217, page 149; and whereas Chas. Brown assigned said note and mortgage to Mrs. Fanny C. Edinger on April 2, 1935 and said lodge was unable to pay the same and whereas, in order to avoid the unnecessary delay and expense of foreclosing said mortgage, the said George W. Williams and B. E. Brown, as the trustees of said lodge, conveyed said lot of land to Sanford L. Thompson by deed dated June 1, 1935 and recorded in said office in Book 184, page 67, upon the understanding that said Thompson would have said mortgage released, so that no judgment should be taken against said lodge or its trustees, and said mortgage has accordingly been released; and whereas all of said transactions were satisfactory to the members of said lodge and for its best interest; and whereas some question has been raised as to the title to said land, because no evidence of the authority of said trustee to execute said deed had been spread upon the public records;

Now, be it resolved by the said White Horse Lodge No. 200 Free and Accepted Masons that the actions of the said George W. Williams and B. E. Brown, as Trustees of said lodge, in executing and delivering said deed to said Sanford L. Thompson, be and it is hereby fully confirmed and ratified; that said lodge recognize the said S. L. Thompson as the owner of said lot of land in fee simple, free of any claims which could now or at any time hereafter be asserted on behalf of said lodge; and that said lodge does hereby grant, bargain, sell, release and forever quitclaim unto said Sanford L. Thompson and his heirs and assigns forever all right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity in and to said land and every part thereof, and does hereby authorize any and all present and future officers of said lodge to execute and deliver any deeds and other papers and to
