COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

E. INMAN,

WHEREAS, Susan C. Gullivan,

on or about the 20th day of February in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty three exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against C. F. Schwing, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th day of September, 1933, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by

E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate
