Meyer, her heirs and assigns forever, all of my one-half interest in all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two and one-half miles from the Greenville County Court House, on a fifty foot unnamed street, which runs from the Fair's Road, Commencing at a point on said street at the Eastern Corner of property owned by Arthur L.
