KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, H. K. Trowers, Trustee
for R. E. Johnson,

in the State aforesaid.

In consideration of the sum of \$1000

DOLLARS,

to me paid by H. K. Trowers, as Trustee for Carolina
Loans & Trust Company, and for Julia D. Charles
Attorney

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said H. K. Trowers, as Trustee for Carolina Loans & Trust
Company, and for Julia D. Charles Attorney
all that place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in Ward One of the City of Greenville, on the west side
of Norwood Place between West Washington Street and
Hampton Avenue, and having the following mates and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the west side of Norwood Place at
the corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Charles, and
thence running N 65° W 75 feet to a stake, thence S 2 3/4 E. 35 feet with the
line of the Riley property, thence S 2 3/4 E. 35 feet with the
Riley line to a stake, thence S 65° W 75 feet to a stake on
Norwood Place, thence along Norwood Place N 2 3/4 E. 35 feet
to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed
to R. E. Johnson by John A. Russell April 30, 1927, by deed re-
corded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume
113 page 208.

Also that other lot of land in the Spartanburg County
and State aforesaid in the City of Greenville adjoining
the above described lot, being the rear portion of the
lot conveyed by Lucie D. Glover and Wilcox Glover to Mrs.
S. F. Riley and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the northeast rear corner
of said lot and running thence S. 27 1/2 W. 35 feet to a stake
thence N. 45° W. 90 1/2 feet to a stake, thence N. 2 3/4 E. 35 feet to
iron pin, thence S 45° E. 90 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, and
being the same conveyed to P. E. Johnson by Mrs. L. A. Arnold and
others by deed dated November 20, 1927 recorded in Deed Book 142, page 167.

This conveyance is made subject to State, County and City taxes
having assessments and mortgages by R. E. Johnson as follows:
1. To Carolina Loan and Trust Co. for \$3500, dated April 30, 1927, recorded in
Book 186, page 78, which is a first mortgage upon the lot just above described
2. To John D. Charles, Attorney for \$600 dated July 26, 1931 recorded in Book 221, page
292, which is a first mortgage upon the second described lot, and a second
mortgage upon the first described lot.

Upon the following trusts, nevertheless: In trust to hold the legal title
to said lots of land, to manage and control the same, to receive the rents
and profits, and out of same to pay taxes, insurance premiums, interest
on mortgage indebtedness, paving assessments, and any repairs which
may be necessary to keep the premises in tenable condition, and after
all expenses are paid to apply the rents to the first mortgage indebtedness
over the property rented. In trust to sell said lots of land at public
or private sale, in his discretion, and apply the proceeds of sale to the
discharge of the indebtedness as above stated, any surplus to be retained
by the trustee as his compensation for carrying out the trust.

The trustee shall have power and authority to execute notes in
general or in lieu of the notes secured by the mortgages above described
and to secure same by mortgage or mortgages over the premises.
Neither purchasers nor mortgagors shall be required to see to the application
of the proceeds of sale or loan. Acceptance of this deed on the part of the beneficiaries of the
trust shall release the estate of R. E. Johnson from any further liability
on account of said indebtedness.
