Nevertheless, upon the following conditions, however, which conditions are part of the consideration for this deed and are expressly for the benefit of all owners of lots as shown on said plat above referred to, to wit:

- (1) No dwelling shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalk than thirty feet.
- (2) The facing of the lots as shown on said plat shall in strictly adhered to, however, more than one lot may be used for the purpose of erecting a dwelling.
- (3) The property herein conveyed shall never be sold, divided or otherwise disposed of to Negroes or persons having any percentage of Negro blood.
- (4) No out building shall be erected nearer to the abutting sidewalk than forty (40) feet.

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof,
