certain tract or lot of land situate, lying and being in Hickory Springs, S.C., all that place, purchased by the said L. S. Schwartzel, his heirs and executors,

brown and designated as tract no. 8, on plat of Arthur S. Agnew property known as Blairmount Ridge and having, according to said plat made by Dalton & Neves, Surveyors, which is of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book "A" at page 182, the following metes and bounds: courses and distances to-wit:

Begins at an iron pin on the southwest side of Piney Mountain Road, which iron pin is at the point corner of tracts 7 and 8, and running thence with the point line of said tracts, S. 45-00 W. 480 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly belonging to Mrs. McDaniel; thence with said McDaniel line, S. 75-30 W. 351.8 feet to an iron pin, thence still said McDaniel line, S. 87-45 W. to a point on the North side of Blairmount Drive, thence with Blairmount Drive to a point in joint line of tracts 8 and 9; thence with the joint line of said tracts N. 47-20 E. 818 feet more or less to an iron pin on the southwest side of Piney Mountain Rd.; thence North said Piney Mountain Rd.
