Beginning at John Brockman's corner
 on Sullivan Street, thence running with
 Sullivan Street S 7° 15' E. 50.5 feet, thence
 with Goldsmith's line S 2° 50' W. 129.1 feet,
 thence N 36° 50' feet with Sullivan Street
 back lot to a point, thence N 3° 30' W. 125.5
 feet with front Brockman line to the
 beginning corner, and being the same lot
