Township, on the White Horse Road, and having the following
metes and bounds, according to survey made by W. J.
Piddle, Surveyor, July 11, 1935.

Beginning at a point in center of White Horse Road,
corner of Taylor's property, and running thence north 34-30
west 413.5 feet to an iron pin; thence north 55-30 west 103.6
feet to an iron pin; thence south 37-55 west 347 feet to a point
on the center of White Horse Road; thence along said road south
27-20 east 140 feet to the beginning corner, containing one acre
more or less, and conveyed to us by Ellen Myers, deed dated
July 15, 1935, recorded Volume 171, page 296.
