AGRERMENT

This memorandum of agreement made and entered into this the 13th day of September 1935, by and between George Bisbikis, and Charles Dautos, hereinafter referred to as the parties of the first part and Ida Gorman doing business in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, as the South Carolina Beer and Wins Company, hereinafter referred to as the party of the second part

Witnesseth:

1. The parties of the first part being engaged in the beer and lunch business on 24 Pendleton Street, An the City of Greenville, South Carolina, agrees and contracts with the party of the second part as follows: that in consideration of the party of the second part, furnishing to the party of the first parties a beer dispensing bar for the price of One Hundred and Sixty (\$160.00) Dollars, the parties of the first part agrees to purchase beer exclusively for the party of the second part at the prevailing price and is to pay two (\$2.00) Dollars additional on each keg of beer purchased which shall be applied to the purchase price of the said beer dispensing bar until paid for in full, and that in the event the parties of the first part fails to perform this convenant, the amount paid prior to such breach shall be and is considered as rantal of the said beer dispensing bar. It is further agreed and understood that the tile to the said bar is to remain in the party of the second part until the full, purchase price is paid in full.

The parties of the second part or its agents, shall have the right to inspect and as certain at all time the kind of ber being handled.

2nd. The party of the second part agrees to the foregoing stipulations and agrees to keep the parties of the first part supplied for time to time keg beer at the prevailing market price. And it is understood that in the event of the breach of the convenants herein the party of the second part shall have the right to the immediate return and delivery of the said bar.
