It is understood that upon said purchaser complying with this contract and delivering to the seller the 100 bales of cotton of the description herainabove set forth on or before twenty years from this date the seiler, his heirs or executors will execute and deliver to said purchaser or his hairs, executors or assigns a good fee simple general warranty deed with down renounced to the premises herein prove referred to, free of all encumbrances.

All taxes after the year 1933 shall be raid by the purchaser.

If is further understook and agreed that the purchaser is not to cut any wood except for his own domestic usa.
