 undivided interest in the lot of land conveyed to S. S. and
 J. M. Hodgene by J. S. Hodgene by his last living will of
 May 26th, 1938 recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County,
 Court Records, in Vol. 126, page 548, having the following metes
 and bounds to wit;

beginning on an iron pin at corner of J. S. Hodgene land
 and the Aug. St. Smith Mill Co. land, and running thence N.
 75 degrees and 3 minutes E. 186 feet and 4 inches to an iron pin,
 thence S. 27 1/2 degrees and 6 inches to an iron pin, thence S.
 75 degrees and 1/2 minutes E. 184 feet and 4 inches to an iron
 pin in the road, thence N. 28 degrees and 45 minutes E. 31 feet
 and 4 inches to an iron pin in the road; thence N. 36 degrees
