I, the record witness, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Selen Jenkinson, her heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lots of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 7, 11, and 27, of the property of J. T. Jenkinson, deceased, Plat of said property being recorded in Plat Book "H", at page 207, in the R. M. C. Office for said county and state, reference is hereby made to said plat for a more particular description of the above numbered lots.

The following building restrictions shall be observed in respect to the above numbered lots for a period of ten years from November 17th, 1933, (1) As to lots Nos. 7, 11, and 27--no dwelling shall be erected in said lots nearer than thirty feet to Lourens Drive, nor to cost less than \$3,000.00, (2) None of the above lots shall be sold, leased or rented to persons of African descent.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Joe T. Jenkinson, et al., on the 17th day of November, 1932, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds, Greenville County, in Book 168, Page 97.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, easements, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, of and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said Helen Jenkinson, and her

heirs and assigns, forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Helen Jenkinson, and her heirs and assigns, against all and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
