By Maeude L. Floyd the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Maeude L. Floyd, and her heirs and assigns forever.

All that certain piece of land situated
lying and being in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, County and
State aforesaid, and having the following Tracts and Bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of East Park
Avenue, 101 feet 34 inches from the northwest corner of the intersection
of Park Avenue and Broadway Street, and runne thence N. 20-45 E.
172 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 77 1/4 E. 50 feet to an iron pin;
thence S. 20-45 W. 172 feet to an iron pin on Park Avenue; thence
with said Avenue S. 77 1/4 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, being part
of the land conveyed to Jessie L. Floyd by C. D. Harboldough by Deed
dated the 18th day of November 1918, and recorded in the R. W. C. Office
for Greenville County in Vol. 42 at page 584, and being the same lot
conveyed to J. H. Rainey, Receiver of Farmers Bank of Central by
