Bowen, and running thence northerly along the said street thirty-two and 83/100 ft. to a stake, on said street; thence N. 61-35 W. eighty-eight and 65/100 ft. to a stake; thence S. 28-15 W. thirty-two and 83/100 ft. to stake on Robt. Bowens' line; thence along his line, S. 61-35 E. eighty-eight and 5/10 ft. to stake on said street, the beginning point.
