All that late tract or parcel of land being in Creek Springs Township, Country of Greenville, State aforesaid and about one mile west of St. Mark Church, adjoining lands of George Young, William Johnson, Edward Loftis and others and having the following metes and bounds:

Begins on a stone on west side of a private road leading from the section about St. Mark Church in a westerly direction to some former house, thence N 22° 34' 28.67 to a stone, thence N 85° 3.78 to stone and d. o. on S 24° 44' 1.49 chains to a stone on George Young lot, thence S 22° E. to stone and d. o. on west side of private road mentioned above, thence S. 65° W. 2.22 chains to beginning corner, and containing two acres, more or less, according to survey made by J.
