All that certain parcel or lot of land situate, lying and  
being in Chick Scoggins Precinct, in the Town of Greenville, County of  
Greenville, State of South Carolina and being more particularly described  
as follows:

Beginning at a stone corner of Arlington Avenue and North  
Main Street formerly Montellier Street, and running thence in  
a northerly direction along North Main Street 120 feet to the corner  
of H. L. M. C. Battle's lot, thence with the H. L. M. C. Battle Line, in a  
westerly direction 229 feet to the end of the H. L. M. C. Battle Line,  
thence South 120 feet to Arlington Avenue, thence East along  
Arlington Avenue 229 feet to the beginning corner.
