lying in Ward 2 of the city of Greenville and more and designated as Lot no 2 in a subdivision of the J. Brattie property as shown on a plat recorded in Plat Book C, at page 30, and having the following  
metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Pettigru Street, at the corner of Lot no 1, and thence with said street N. 76.45 E. 55 feet 8 inches to a stake at the corner of Lot no 3, thence along the line of that lot S. 15 E. 196 feet to a stake, thence S. 76.45 W. 55 feet 8 inches to the stake at the rear corner of Lot no 1, thence along the line of that lot N. 15 W. 196 feet to the beginning corner having the same lot conveyed to me by J.
