Mrs. Lillie G. Balsentine, all that lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North East corner of Rutherford and Randall Street, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and having the following corner and bounds:

Beginning at an stake at the corner of Rutherford and Randall Street and running thence with Rutherford Street N. 1. 22 E. 79.3 feet to a stake; thence in an easterly direction 202.2 feet to a stake on a 12 foot alley (which stake is 90.5 feet from Randall Street); and thence with said alley S. 1. 22 W. 40.5 feet to a stake on Randall Street; and thence with Randall Street N. 1. 22 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner, being all of the lot conveyed to Maude P. Bushman by Eva L. McHugh by deed dated Oct 4th, 1915, and recorded in book 38 page 33, and a portion of the lot conveyed to Maude P. Bushman by Edna E.
