Clyde M. Hester, All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Easley Bridge Road and Saluda River, being known and designated as Tract No. 10 as shown on Plat made by Dalton & Nease, October, 1932, and recorded in Plat Book N. page 212 and 213, and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat:
Beginning at an iron pin, corner of tract no. 11 and running thence S. 56-51 W. 665 feet to an iron pin corner of tract No. 9; thence with line of Tract No. 9, N. 51-20 W. 130 feet to an iron pin in line of Tract No. 8; thence with line of tract No. 8 N. 22-08 E. 664 feet to an iron pin corner of tract no. 11; thence with line of tract No. 11, S. 51-30 E. 1514 feet to beginning corner.
