J. R. Hicks, his heirs and assigns forever:
All that piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being in East Township, Seventy and State aforesaid, containing Twenty (20) acres, more or less, and being bounded on the South by lands of W. P. Aiken and J. D. Harris, Jr.; on the West and North by lands of John H. Hicks; on the East by lands of John H. Hicks and W. P. Aiken. This being the identical tract of land conveyed to me the said Benjamin F. Black by James S. Black, by deed dated December 14, 1896, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume N N N, at page 249.

Less, however, one (1) acre of land heretofore conveyed by me to W. P. Aiken, see Judgment Roll E 3983 filed in Court's Office for Greenville County. This being a portion of the land conveyed to me, the said Benjamin F. Black, and my brother James S. Black, by deed of J. Black et al, recorded in Volume 27, at page 1859, R. M. C.
