of Greenville, South Carolina, and more particularly de-
scribed as follows: Beginning at a stake on the north
side of the road leading from York Slope to Lickville,
J. M. Austin's corner and running thence N. 19° 30' W. 376 feet
to a stake in line of tract no 1 as shown on plan of
the State Manufacturing Company lands made by J. C.
Rogers, December 1916; thence with line of said tract no
1 W. 66 E. 100 feet to stake, thence S. 19° 30' E. 276 feet to
