 Beginning at a corner on the left bank of Head of Tyger River
 just near the State Road; thence up the head of Tyger River as a
 line 23.40 chains to a branch; thence up said branch as a line
 5.30 chains to a stake, thence N. 18 1/2 W. 3.50 chains to a stake on line
 of the M. K. Robertson lands (now owned by Lanford and Kendrick)
 thence with line of said lands in a westerly direction to lands of Sherman
