Godfrey Webster road, thence along his line N. 79 W. 812 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 81-50 W. 780 feet to an iron pin at front corner of tract of E. Godfrey Webster and tract formerly belonging to R. Peycle Webster, thence along the R. Peycle Webster line N. 27 W. 270 feet to rear iron pin, thence S. 47-30 W. 570 feet to corner of the said R. Peycle Webster tract, iron pin and stone, thence S. 43-10 W. 1009 feet to an iron pin corner of tract formerly belonging to Mrs. A. b.
