All that certain piece, part or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Peak Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the head water of Enore River, containing thirty-three and fifty-one hundredths (33.51) acres more or less, and having the following course and distances and boundaries, to-wit: Beginning at an iron stake on North side of County Highway on line of State lines thence N. 89^W with State line 24.58 chs. to stone (State corner), thence S. 33^E. 4.59 chs. to iron pin (on State line), thence S. 75^E. 22.80 to iron pin on north side of County Highway, thence N. 32^E. 81 with Highway 16.55 chs. to beginning corner being a part of the estate lands of Geo. St. Meece, deceased, and before fully shown on a plat of said lands made by M. C. Divers, surveyor, at a survey made March 1st., and 6th, 1935 and re-surveyed on said plat as the home tract.
