the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Bellton Light and Power Company, its successors and  
assigns, forever:

The right to grow and cultivate any part of the  
premises hereinafter described by a dam either now  
erected, or to be erected, at any point on Saluda River,  
the premises being all that certain tract of land situated  
in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina,  
containing fifty-acre and one-half (51 1/2) acres, more or less,  
bounded on the West by Saluda River, on the North by lands  
of George W. Suborn, on the South by lands of J. B. and Mary  
Kosciusko Johnson, and on the East by lands now or formerly,  
of J. S. Johnson. This is the same tract of land conveyed by  
Louvinia Brown to the grantor herein by deed dated April 21,
