M. 32; thence S. 63° 30' E. 40 chains to a stake on N. 1/4 South line, thence N. 5° E. 25.87 chains to a stake on side of road; thence N. 67° E. 10.37 chains to a stone F. M. Morgan's corner; thence S. 51° E. 14.55 chains to a stake; thence N. 34° E. 28.18 chains to a stone; b.
