Beginning on S.P. on south bank of Enoree River, William Barton corner, thence S. 82° 28'. 6. 24 chains to I. P. in a exposed road, thence N. 78° 36'. 1. 60 chains to I. P., thence N. 12° 6'. 6. 24 chains to I. P. on south bank of Enoree River, thence with Enoree River as the line to the beginning corner, and containing one acres, more or less.
