Lupo and running thence S. 7-20 W. 84 feet to a stake on said Old Augusta Road, corner of lot now or formerly owned by W. B. Lupo; thence along the line of said lot N. 78-20 E. 218 feet to a stake on the New Augusta Road; thence with said New Augusta Road N. 14-20 W. 80 feet to a stake, corner of lot of Ida L. Lupo; thence along the line of said lot S. 78-20 W. 254, to the beginning corner, and containing one-half acre, more or less.
