Mayfields corner and running thence along Mayfields

1491 feet to pin in said road, thence N. 78-30 W. 845 feet
to iron pin at the branch, thence S. 88-45 E. 920 feet to
stone, in road, thence along the road N. 54-45 E. 151 feet to the beginning corner
