in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500)

DOLLARS,

to us paid by Jas H. Earle

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Jas H. Earle, his heirs and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in North Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and on the east side of Purkin's Mill Road, about three and one half miles from Greenville Court House, and containing ninety-one (91) acres, more or less, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stone on the west bank of Reedy River, Cagle's corner, thence S 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 35.50 chains to Parker's Mill Road; thence with the center of said road N. 52 W. 3.50 to an angle in said road; thence N. 50 W. 12.32 to Johnson's corner, thence with Johnson's line N. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10.52 to a stone; thence N. 47 E. 23.74; thence N. 25 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 11.75 to stone on D. J. Smith line; thence with Smith's line N. 66 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 8 to a stone on River Bank; thence down said river to beginning corner.

This deed is made subject to all taxes owing on said land and the mortgage recorded in mortgage Book 29, page 160, and is declaratory that title was held in trust for said Joseph H. Earle and to vest in said Joseph H. Earle, title free from any trusts.
