in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mrs. Maude Boyd:-

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, located near Hopewell Rural School, on waters of Ripple Creek, branch waters of Reedy River, bounded by lands of E.
